


# Wenatchee River at Plain, Wash





**Study Reach.**--Section 1 is 1,360 ft upstream from gage.

**Gage Location.**--Lat 47°45'50", long 120°39'30", in lot 8, sec.12, T.26N., R.17E., on left bank at Plain, 0.25 mile downstream from Beaver Creek, 7.5 miles downstream from Nason Creek, and 12 miles north of Leavenworth. Section 1 is 1,360 ft upstream from gage.

**Drainage Area.**--591 sq mi.

**Gage Datum and Elevations of Reference Points.**--Not available.

**Stage, Discharge Measurements and Computed n-Values.**--Gage heights were 12.43 ft at gage; 16.50 ft at section 1. Peak discharges was 22,700 cfs. on May 29, 1948.



**Description of Channel.**--Bed is boulders;  $d_{50} = 162$  mm,  $d_{85} = 320$  mm. Banks are lined with trees and bushes.
